Want to be an ATL?

Campers requesting to be considered for the position of ATL **MUST**:

- Write ATL REQUEST in RED at the top left side of their application.
- <u>Attach</u> a letter explaining your qualifications and reasons for your ATL request. Last years ATLs are given first preference. ATL selection is finalized in mid-July;

submit your application with ATL request to the Scout Service Center by Friday, June 26, 2020.
