



Items to Bring

Scouts should always bring these essential items with them to every campout.

- Pocketknife and totin chit (in a bag labeled with name and troop number if totin chit hasn't been earned yet)
- First-aid kit
- Extra clothing
- Rain gear and cold weather gear for being outside
- Water bottle
- Flashlight
- Matches and fire starters and tinder and firemen chit (in a bag labeled with name and troop number if firemen chit hasn't been earned yet)
- Sun protection
- Compass
- Hat
- Swimwear and towel
- No open toe shoes
- Sleeping bag for sleeping
- Tents (adults will sleep separately from Scouts and will each need a tent)
- Sleeping mats are optional - based on your Scouts preferences
- Mess kit for eating (pan, plate, cup, silverware)
- Toiletries kit (toothbrush, comb, etc...)
- Scout book and writing utensil
- Bug spray
- Weather appropriate clothing (including their Class A Tan uniform for flag ceremonies and class B T-Shirt if they have one. We will be outside doing activities. Having extra socks and pants are always good in case a Scout does get wet. Clothes to sleep in will also be needed.)
- A bag or backpack to carry the Scouts equipment around
