Learning for Life features grade-appropriate, theme-oriented lesson plans to be used in the classroom to enhance and support the classroom program. Lessons are designed to be conducted by teachers in conjunction with the core curriculum. The Learning for Life lesson plans are research-based and contain character development traits uniquely blended into lessons that are aligned to core curriculum standards in all 50 states.

Learning for Life is an action-learning process and uses teaching techniques such as role-playing, small-group discussions, reflective and moral dilemma exercises, online interactive lessons and hands-on activities. The reflective portion of each lesson is the pivotal point at which youth have the opportunity to think about what they have learned and integrate the experience into real life. Learning for Life in Three Harbors Council serves more than 10,500 young people in more than 40 different school-based programs.

The career-based component of Learning for Life is called Exploring. Exploring has partnered with more than 30 businesses and organizations like the Milwaukee Police Department and local fire departments to bring "real-world" career experiences to young men and women. Exploring programs provide an ideal, interactive link between the academic environment and the real world.
