When: Sunday, October 6, from 1:00 – 5:00 p.m.


Where: Wisconsin Humane Society, 4500 W. Wisconsin Avenue, Milwaukee

Important information:

There are ten requirements for this badge, eight of which can be signed off on the day of the clinic. **Requirements #4 and #5 must be completed on your own.** If you do these prior to the workshop and <u>bring your documentation with you</u> to the clinic, we can sign off on everything that day and *you are done!* If you complete the requirements after the clinic, just coordinate with the Merit Badge Counselor to get your blue card signed.

Although you are not required to have a dog to attend this workshop, a dog is required to complete requirement #4 and #5. Boy Scouts who are considering adopting a dog may want to attend to find out more about the responsibilities and care dogs require. You can attend the workshop and complete the last two requirements when you do add a canine family member to your pack. You can also borrow a friend, neighbor, or family member's dog for these requirements.

Interested in helping homeless animals? Consider organizing a donation drive prior to attending the clinic. Collect cat and dog toys, peanut butter, treats, and/or new or gently used blankets and towels from friends, family, and neighbors to help the animals at the Wisconsin Humane Society.
