Cost: \$18 per scout. Due to space restrictions related to physical distancing, we ask that adults do not attend with their scout unless absolutely necessary.

Important information:

There are ten requirements for this badge, eight of which can be signed off on the day of the clinic. Requirements #4 and #5 must be completed on your own. If you do these prior to the workshop and bring your documentation with you to the clinic, we can sign off on everything that day and you are done! If you

complete the requirements after the clinic, you can coordinate with the Merit Badge Counselor to get your blue card signed.

The health and safety of the young people who attend our programs is our top priority, and we have made some important changes to ensure safety, including:

- Limiting enrollment to eight scouts to maintain physical distancing
- Limiting the number of people in the shelter building for other services
- Asking participants and staff to abide by a health policy and stay home if ill
- Increasing cleaning and handwashing before, during, and after the program
- Moving activities outside as possible
- Requiring all participants and staff to wear masks when inside
