In 2001, the Lutheran Association of Scouters created an award to recognize <u>any</u> chartered organization that places emphasis on "Duty to God" and "A Scout is Reverent".

Jack Weintraub was a professional Scouter who gave leadership as the advisor to the Lutheran Association of Scouters. When he retired he remained active as a volunteer with the group, and had been serving as the president when passed away from a massive stroke. Jack's interest in faith development and character building for our youth through Scouting is well documented. It is in his memory that this award was created.

Here are the guidelines:

- 1. Participate in a Scout Sabbath or Scout Sunday observance
- 2. The members in the unit complete a service project for a church or religious organization. The unit can choose a nearby church to provide a service project for.
- 3. Unit maintains a record of Scouts who have received or are presently working on the religious emblem for their faith. There must be at least 10% of the youth membership involved in working on their religious emblem or have received it.
- 4. Complete application for the Jack Weintraub Award recognition.
