Without the support of parents and leaders like you, Scouting would not be possible. The funds from the Friends of Scouting Campaign are used for things you may not see every day but are vital to providing a first-class Scouting experience for your child. This includes accident and liability insurance for your units, maintaining our camps to keep the cost of camp programing affordable, and helping ensure all youth can participate in the Scouting through the Council's outreach programs.

The campaign also supports the full-time staff at our camps and Scout Service Centers who keep the Scouting movement growing in southeast Wisconsin. Council staff are trained, dedicated individuals whom you can contact to seek advice, learn about BSA resources, and discuss sensitive situations if they arise. They are your greatest resource to help your unit succeed, including recruiting new Scouts every fall.

Tonight, we invite you to help keep Scouting thriving in our Council. For \$200 you can support one Scout for an entire year. That's \$16 a month or less than \$4 a week. If you can support at a higher level, consider two Scouts at \$400 or becoming a Star or Eagle level donor. We also know that not every family can make a gift at these levels. A gift of ANY AMOUNT is welcome. \$100, \$50, or \$20 is vital to keeping the Scouting movement strong in southeast Wisconsin. Every contribution is important and 100% of your contribution stays to support local day-to-day Scouting operations in Kenosha, Milwaukee, and Racine counties.



You also do NOT have to pay your gift tonight. You can make a pledge and pay throughout the year by indicating on your pledge card if you would like to pay once, twice or four times between now and December 31, 2023.

At this time, I want you to take a look at the pledge card in the Family FOS brochure. Please fill out your name, contact information, and the amount of your gift. Even if you choose not to give, I want you to fill out your card and put \$0 in the "Other" amount. If you turn in a \$0 amount, the Council will know not to include you in follow-up calls or mailings.

You can also make your gift online using the QR code printed on your brochure. If you choose to give online, please put your name on the card and indicate "Gave Online" so we can follow up to ensure your gift is received. If your company matches, indicate the company you work for. Matching gifts in most cases must be initiated by the employee; if you're not sure how to do this, talk to the HR staff in your company. Finally, indicate your method of payment if you are making a partial or full payment tonight.

I will be located (where in the room you'll be located) ______ throughout the meeting to collect pledge cards and share the total raised with your unit leadership.
