



National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) is an intense week-long, youth-oriented leadership training experience for Scouts BSA, Sea Scouts, and Venturers. Highly qualified youth staff, under the supervision of adult advisers, will teach participants the concepts of what a leader must BE, what a leader must KNOW, and what a leader must DO.
